

## **ST. MARY OF THE ASSUMPTION DRESS CODE**

*The School Uniform is a special sign telling others who our students are and to whom they belong. Students who are well groomed, neat, and clean have a certain pride about themselves that is reflected in their actions. Our students are a group of dedicated young people proud to be counted as Christ's disciples and willing to try to make a difference in becoming all God intends them to be. They hope to make our world a better place because they are a part of it. Our School Uniform should be worn with dignity and pride!*

### **GIRLS – GRADES K-3** □

Blue glen plaid jumpers – V-neck

Split skirt with vest

Girls Sweaters: Navy, royal blue, white, gray cardigan with jumper

Girls Blouses/Polo Shirts (Spirit Wear): Light blue, navy, white, or royal blue

Girls Broad cloth – Peter Pan round collar or tailored pointed collar

Girls Oxford cloth – button-down tailored collar

Girls Turtleneck – white only

Girls Slacks: Navy or Khaki (corduroy/twill/polyester). No cargo pants

Girls Socks: Only solid colored navy, white, or gray crew or knee socks or tights (no spandex, sweatpants, etc. under the skirt). **NO ATHLETIC SOCKS**

### **GIRLS – GRADES 4-5** □

Blue glen plaid kilt skirt or split skirt with Navy twill open vest. **(Skirt MUST be no shorter than 1” above the knee.)**

Girls Sweaters/Vests: **PLAIN** navy, royal blue, white, gray sweaters (crew, cardigan, V-neck)

Girls Blouses/Polo Shirts (Spirit Wear): Light blue, navy, white, or royal blue.

Girls Broad cloth – Peter Pan round plain collar or tailored pointed collar

Girls Oxford cloth – Button-down tailored collar

***Blouses must be tucked into skirts or slacks.***

Girls Slacks: Navy or Khaki (corduroy/twill/polyester)

No cargo pants

Girls Socks: **\*Only solid colored navy, white, or gray KNEE SOCKS or CREW SOCKS or TIGHTS\*** (no spandex, sweatpants, etc. under the skirt) **NO ATHLETIC SOCKS**

### **GIRLS – GRADES 6-8** □

Blue glen plaid kilt skirt or split skirt with Navy twill open vest. **(Skirt MUST be no shorter than 1” above the knee.)**

Girls Blouses/Polo Shirts:

Girls Oxford cloth – pointed collar, long or short sleeve (white, navy, or light blue). Blue and white Spirit Wear polo shirts also may be worn.

Girls Long sleeve white turtleneck shirts may be worn under the blouse. **Only “WHITE” garments may be worn under the uniform blouse. Blouses must be tucked into skirts or slacks.**

Girls Sweaters/vests: **PLAIN** navy, royal blue, white, gray sweaters (crew, cardigan, V-neck)

Girls Slacks: Navy or Khaki (corduroy/twill/polyester). If the pants have loops, a belt must be worn. No cargo pants. No low-rider pants.

Girls Socks: **\*Only solid colored navy, white, or gray KNEE SOCKS or CREW SOCKS or TIGHTS\*** (no spandex, sweatpants, etc. under the skirt) **NO ATHLETIC SOCKS.** If tights are not worn, kick pants or shorts must be worn underneath the skirt. **If your daughter's skirt is too short, tights will be mandated after the first infraction.**

□ Clothes and footwear should be of the style available in the girls' clothing department.

**BOYS – GRADES K-8**

Boys Shirts: Navy, white, light blue or royal blue knit polo (short or long sleeve). **Only PLAIN WHITE t-shirts may be worn under uniform polo shirts. Shirts must be tucked in.**

Boys Sweaters: Navy, white, gray, royal blue (Crew, V-neck, Cardigan) solid not trimmed with a color

Boys Slacks: Navy or khaki dress pants (no cargo pants; no elastic leg). **BELTS MUST BE WORN.**

Boys Socks: Only solid colored navy, white, or black crew socks **must** be worn.

**NO ATHLETIC SOCKS**

☐ Clothes and footwear should be of the style available in the boys’ clothing department.

**GIRLS**

**SHOES:** Black or brown leather-like dress shoes must be worn. The shoes must have a functional “buckle,” tie, or Velcro with a maximum one-inch heel. Shoes are to be purchased in the girls’ shoe department.

**\*NOT ACCEPTABLE SHOES GIRLS:**

NO CLOGS; NO NEON SOLES, STRIPES, LACES; NO NAMES; NO FLASHING LIGHTS, ETC., NO TENNIS SHOES OR MOCCASINS

**BOOTS:**

**BOOTS:** Winterized boots are needed activities and should be worn to school during inclement weather. They may not be worn as part of the uniform during regular school hours. Boots are to be purchased in the girls’ shoe department.

**JEWELRY:** *Girls may wear only one pair of small post earrings. NO dangle earrings.*

No extra earrings may be worn on the outer extremities. Watch; religious jewelry may be worn inside blouses or shirts. One bracelet may be worn. NO tattoos.

**GIRLS**

**MAKE-UP:** **NO MAKEUP IS PERMITTED.**  
**No nail polish or acrylic nails.**

**HAIRSTYLE:** Neat, presentable – not covering the facial area. NO EXTREMES (rows, lines, shaved, any enhancements (feathers, beads, etc.) NO UNNATURAL HAIR COLORS

**BOYS**

**SHOES:** Black or brown leather-like dress shoes must be worn. The shoes must have a functional “buckle,” tie, or Velcro. Shoes are to be purchased in the boys’ shoe department.

**\*NOT ACCEPTABLE SHOES BOYS:**

NO CLOGS; NO NEON SOLES, STRIPES, LACES; NO NAMES; NO FLASHING LIGHTS, ETC., NO TENNIS SHOES OR MOCCASINS

Winterized boots are outside

for outside activities and should be worn to school during inclement weather. They may not be worn as part of the uniform during regular school hours. Boots are to be purchased in the boys’ shoe department.

**JEWELRY:** Watch; religious jewelry may be worn inside the shirt. NO earrings or tattoos.

**BOYS**

**HAIRSTYLE:** Neat and shorter than collar length. Must be above the eyebrows. NO EXTREME STYLES (rows, lines, ridges, step cuts, tails, shaved). NO UNNATURAL HAIR COLORS, Clean Shaven

**ST. MARY SWEATSHIRT-AVAILABLE THROUGH LANDS END or SPIRIT WEAR:** St. Mary sweatshirts may be worn as part of the school uniform. A POLO SHIRT OR BLOUSE MUST BE WORN UNDERNEATH.

**\*\*Uniforms must be neat and clean at all times. Any child not in proper uniform will first receive a warning. If another violation occurs, the student will receive a dress code demerit.**

### **Gym Clothes**

The students in grades K-8 ARE TO WEAR their gym uniforms and tennis shoes for the entire school day on their gym day(s). From November-March, students may wear St. Mary (royal) blue, CYO gray, or spirit store sweatpants over their gym uniforms.

**Grades K-5:** St. Mary's regulation gym T-shirts and shorts (must be purchased through the school) and athletic tie shoes.

**Junior High: Gym uniforms must be purchased from Schoolbelle's ONLY.**

Boys K-8 must wear boys' regulation gym t-shirts, shorts, shoes and socks in a style available in the boys' clothing department.

Girls K-8 must wear girls' regulation gym t-shirts, shorts, shoes and socks in a style available in the girls' clothing department.

### **Summer Uniform Option**

During the months of August, September, May and June, students may wear navy or khaki Schoolbelle's uniform walking shorts in place of their jumpers/skirts/pants. They may wear navy, white, light blue or royal blue knit polo shirts along with their shorts. Clean tennis shoes are acceptable with the summer uniform only.

### **Designated Non-Uniform Days**

Students will be given special days on which they may wear clothing other than the regular uniform. On these days (birthdays, contribution bonus days, earned non-uniform days, etc.) the student may wear Capri pants, slacks, jeans, sweatpants, sweatshirts, appropriate slogan T-shirts, tennis shoes/socks.

Inappropriate attire includes leggings, pants with holes, shorts, spaghetti strap shirts/tanks, cropped blouses or shirts, short skirts/dresses, tight fitting attire, midriff blouses, low-rider pants, low cut blouses, spandex, sandals/flip flops, pajama pants.

Boys K-8 must wear clothing for non-uniform days in a style available in the boys' clothing department.

Girls K-8 must wear clothing for non-uniform days in a style available in the girls' clothing department.

**Outerwear/jackets** for boys K-8 must be in a style available in the boys' clothing department.

**Outerwear/jackets** for girls K-8 must be in a style available in the girls' clothing department.

Please note that we tried allowing the girls to wear leggings with tops that covered the girls' bottoms. After many attempts, it was decided by administration that leggings are **NOT PERMITTED**.
