**CATHEDRAL LATIN SCHOLARSHIP**  
**Nomination for the 2020-2021 School Year**

**Criteria/Guidelines for Principals**

1. Principals from *each* DTA Participating Catholic high school in the Catholic Diocese of Cleveland will nominate one recipient to receive the \$1,000 **Cathedral Latin Scholarship (CLS)** based on the following criteria:
  - a. Recipient must demonstrate academic achievement defined as an average of **B** or **3.00**, with no grade below a **C**.
  - b. Recipient must display **leadership** and **service commitment**.
  - c. The recipient's family must complete a **FACTS Grant & Aid application**.
2. The principal will write a brief statement (on the back of this sheet, or typed on a separate sheet) as to why this student is being nominated, based on their leadership and service commitment, as well as their financial need.
3. It is the intent of the Catholic Education Endowment Trust (CEET) Advisory Board that the scholarship should be awarded to the same student over the four-year period, **if** the above criteria are maintained. In the event your **CLS** recipient transfers to another school, he/she forfeits the scholarship; you are then entitled to select a replacement recipient, using the same criteria.
4. **CLS** Recipients **may be eligible** for additional diocesan tuition assistance.
